Indicative yearly costs of staff categories

The costs provided in this document are indicative and should help you elaborate your EOS project budget. If you have any further questions, please contact the respective funding foundation.

F.R.S.-FNRS

Staff category	FNRS indicative costs (€)
Scientific - PhD student (grant)	39,500
Scientific - PhD student (salary)	57,200
Scientific - Post-doc *	-
Technician (salary capped) **	60,700
Non-doctoral researcher (salary)	63,300

* Check with your institution that the amount requested for the postdoctoral researcher corresponds to his/her status (mobility situation, employee, etc.) and his/her salary scale.

**At FNRS, the indicative cost for a technician is a lump sum/year that will be reimbursed proportionally to the declared working months (60,700 (full time) / 30,900 (half time)).

FWO

The real cost has to be used when the name(s) of the researcher(s) is (are) already known. For more information on the exact amounts please contact your host institution. When the name(s) of the researcher(s) is (are) not yet known, the following indicative amounts need to be used:

Staff category	FWO indicative costs (€)
Predoctoral researcher with stipend (bursary)	45,000 – 50,000
Predoctoral researcher with salary, 0 years of seniority	65,000 – 70,000
Postdoctoral researcher, 4 years of seniority	85,000 – 90,000
Technical staff, 6 years of seniority	55,000 – 60,000



If you are planning to request budget for staff costs at a TYPE IV institution, staff costs in accordance to those at the foreign TYPE IV institution need to be given.
