CANDIDACY

The part-time Veterinary M.D. Ph.D. Specialist fellowship of the Fund for Scientific Research-FNRS (F.R.S.-FNRS) is part of the categories related to the personnel that one can recruit via the "Research Project" instrument (PDR).

The "Research Credit, Research Project and Equipment" instruments are governed by specific [rules and regulations](#).

OBJECTIVE OF THE FELLOWSHIP

A part-time research fellowship applicable for a two-year period and renewable four times may be granted to clinical veterinary specialists registered by the Veterinary Medical College (Ordre des médecins vétérinaires) if the following conditions are met:

- To be employed in a full-time position in the University Veterinary Clinic (Clinique Vétérinaire Universitaire) of the French-speaking Community of Belgium, at the latest by the validation deadline fixed for the academic authorities (rectors);
- To devote at least half of their time to a research work within the framework of an agreement funded by the F.R.S.-FNRS.

In the event the clinical veterinarian does not hold a Ph.D. including a thesis defense, the fellowship will aim at obtaining the Ph.D. in Veterinary Sciences under the Graduate College in Veterinary Sciences attached to the F.R.S.-FNRS.
